




ESG is part of the organic DNA of Qualitas Energy; we are proud to have been a leader in this space for over 18 years

ESG Wins at Qualitas Energy

- 1.4 million homes supplied with clean energy through Qualitas Energy electricity generation¹
- >2.2 GWh total renewable energy generated in 2022 and up to Q3 2023.
- 1.32 million of tCO2-eq emissions avoided²

ESG Integration at Qualitas Energy

- Qualitas Energy's ESG framework incorporates policies that require the identification and management of ESG issues throughout the investment lifecycle
- Qualitas Energy applies ESG metrics on two levels: internally amongst its employees and office management, and externally across its investments
- Qualitas Energy prioritizes ESG issues that are considered relevant and important to our business and our community
